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What is GAPP?

Master's Programs

- Recruitment and conversion strategy for all MS program
- Manage Viterbi International Offices (Beijing, Shanghai and Bangalore)
- Student Services
 - approval of OPT, CPT, petitions,
 - work with departments on issues / opportunities
 - Advisement is handled at the department level
 - Build a sense of community and positive experience for MS students
 - Events (commencement, orientation, etc..)
- Track and address academic performance
 - Monitor and send probation letters to all who below 3.0
 - Work with departments on evaluating students who should be reviewed for dismissal
 - Academic integrity issues

- DEN@Viterbi is a *delivery mechanism* for graduate engineering education
- **Programs delivered:**
 - 40+ M.S. degrees
 - 5 graduate certificates
 - Over 80% of M.S. courses are available via DEN
- Approximately 850 students enroll in the same MS degree programs and take their courses completely on-line via DEN
- Courses are streamed live via the internet and available as an archive via streaming video, download, podcast, etc..
- DEN operations
 - 7:30 – 10:30 Monday – Friday
 - 13 DEN equipped studio classrooms, ICT Auditorium, SGM Auditoriums
 - Faculty Support Center
 - Help Desk available 7 days per week
 - Support 140+ courses / semester

Professional Programs (non-credit)



Aviation Safety Program – Established in 1952

- 20 courses to nearly 1000 students each year in a personal, hands-on, format.
- Students gain the knowledge to establish safety programs, investigate aircraft accidents, become expert witnesses, and deal with human factor issues.

Ph.D. Student Outreach

Admission, Financial Aid, and Conversion

- Your liaison to other offices at USC for Ph.D related matters; student admission; coordinate the selection process for internal (Viterbi Dean's Doctoral Merit Fellowships, AMI Fellowships, Chevron, others) and external fellowships (GOOGLE, INTEL, others).
- Manages Dean's fellowship obligations year to year.

Student Progress Monitoring

- Monitor academic progress; retention issues; qualifying and defense; time to degree; and approves faculty committees for qualifying examination and defense on behalf of the Graduate School.
