Program Learning Objectives

The purpose of the USC Viterbi School of Engineering Engineer Degree program in Astronautical Engineering is to prepare students for employment in the aerospace industry that requires comprehensive, advanced engineering training, but not necessarily the research orientation developed by a Ph.D. student. The Engineer Degree in Astronautical Engineering is a terminal degree. Students who complete the degree will not be considered for admission to a Ph.D. program.

 able to implement innovative research practices addressing the interdisciplinary nature of
 complex problems under the guidance of their faculty advisor.
- USC students enrolled in the Astronautical Engineering Engineer Degree program will
 demonstrate understanding of applying contemporary research practices addressing the
 interdisciplinary nature of complex problems in engineering practice, especially those
 requiring comprehensive advanced engineering training, and be able to engage in
 innovative practices informed by such research pertinent to Astronautical Engineering in
 diverse contexts.
