

GLORY'S TOP 5 TIPS FOR TECH INTERNSHIP SUCCESS



Talk to someone your own age. Become best friends with someone young on your team: an intern, a recent grad, or someone who has been in the industry 1-2 years. Your peers are your “go-to” people to ask questions or work together with.



Try to set up one-on-ones during the first two weeks with at least half the people on your team. This helps you learn about their roles at the company and expands your connections.

Always communicate with your manager about what you’re working on and your status. Ask them to meet for 15 minutes to discuss what you’re working on and what you can do better.
